

# **TPC Church Camp**

**Friday 7 – Sunday 9 March 2025**  
**The Pines, Tuross Head**

## **Location**

The address is 36 Craddock Rd, Tuross Head NSW.

Access is via the Kings Highway to Batemans Bay, then south on the Princes Highway through Moruya and Coila, before turning left onto Hector McWilliam Drive to Tuross Head. Tuross Head is about 200 km from Canberra, so allow about 2 ½ hours travel time. See map.

## **Site Information**

Mobile reception can be patchy, the campsite is not fenced and some areas are bordered by bushland. Please be aware of where your children are. It is worth noting that the hall is used by a small local church every Sunday morning. As local attendees for that service typically park on the grass at the back of the hall, this area will need to remain free from TPC vehicles and tents.

Entry to the site is via Craddock Rd. Park in front of the Dining room. If you are camping you can enter via the gates on Raleigh Cres. If you need electricity set up on the street side of the back steps near the building.

## **Accommodation options**

### **Rooms: Main block**

Each bed is supplied with a pillow and a mattress protector so **bring all your own sleeping gear: sheets, blankets/sleeping bag, and pillowcases**. The rooms are at either end of the dining hall and kitchen. Rooms are numbered and have been allocated for those who registered for them. Rooms contain 2 single beds, or bunks.

### **Bunkhouses**

Bring all your own sleeping gear (sheets, blanket/sleeping bag, pillow, pillowcase etc). When you arrive the dormitories are on the left hand side of the dining hall and kitchen. The closest bunkhouse and toilets/showers will be allocated for females. The further bunkhouse and toilets/showers will be for males. The toilets/showers are under each bunkhouse.

### **On Site Camping**

Tent / camper sites are on the oval behind the Dining room, off Raleigh Cres. Please keep tents around the edges or near the Dining room. Tents can also be set up next to the bunkhouses.

## **Food**

We are self-catering for camp from supper on Fri evening till Sunday lunch. Our cooks this year are Jazz, Sophie and Charmaine Brookes and Trevor Smallwood. There will be a roster for orderlies for setting up before meals and cleaning up after meals.

Please bring something (nut free) for morning tea or supper to share.
